

# Spot the signs



**Circle any sexual exploitation indicators you can spot in this person's car.**

Indicators or 'signs' help those around a victim realise they might be in danger. Sexual exploitation is difficult to detect as many signs can just be regular behaviour, and will often be far more subtle than this scene.

Speak to a trusted adult if you are worried someone and have notice a change in behaviour relating to signs of sexual exploitation

# Spot the Signs Answers



Signs of sexual exploitation can be difficult to distinguish and you may or may not have identified some signs that could be just normal teenage behaviour or signs of other unrelated issues – that’s ok.

If you spot a change in behaviour and are worried about a young person you know, ask a trusted adult for advice. If someone you know is in danger, call 999 immediately.

**Answers:** Porn on phone, overnight bag, cigarettes, money, joints, underwear, lots of phones (burner phones), alcohol, packet of drugs, change of clothes, young people being picked up/dropped off.
