Our guide of the resources available for schools to help young people protect themselves and friends against grooming and sexual or criminal exploitation.
















Not In Our Community (NIOC) is an anti-grooming campaign commissioned by The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside.

NIOC raises awareness within communities and helps young people in the Humber area understand how grooming and exploitation works so that they can better protect themselves, spot the warning signs amongst friends and know who they can go to for help.

NIOC is aimed at early intervention and prevention. We co-produce resources and stories based on real life events for use on social media, in schools and in other groups where young people hang out.











Available on the Not In Our Community website, NIOC Connect is an open access online resource, designed for use in classroom settings, that enables educators and practitioners to filter films and read-aloud stories by age group, subject matter and victim/perpetrator profile.

Supporting lesson plans are provided for all films and read-aloud stories with activities to help students understand the key themes and learning points.

There are also films and supporting home learning lesson plans available on the Home Learning section of our website which can be completed by students individually or with the support of a parent or guardian.

NIOC Interact

An interactive e-learning platform created to help users learn interactively through short films in order to protect themselves and friends from grooming leading to sexual and criminal exploitation, including County Lines exploitation.

- Set-up pathways suitable for school years 6, 7 to 9 and 10 to 11.
- Suitable for a one-off or series of sessions in or out of school/groups.
- Tracks progress and notifies group leaders on progressed achieved.
- Certificate of achievement for learners completing modules.
- Provides aspects of 'being safe and respectful relationships' learning objectives of Relationships and Sex Education (RSE).
