Funded In-School Sessions Tackling Grooming & Exploitation

The Not In Our Community campaign now offers schools and other education providers funded in-school sessions for students across the Humber area.

Launched in Summer 2022:



The pilot scheme has been funded by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside and has already seen NIOC providing interactive workshops to hundreds of children across primary and secondary education, supporting the early intervention and prevention of grooming leading to criminal and sexual exploitation.



The content has been developed by a team with 8 years' experience of creating learning materials through films and resources co-produced with young people and professionals in the Humber area, and delivery is provided by a professional with 18 years' teaching experience.

This is a building agenda and works to an objective within my Police and Crime Plan (available at www.humberside-pcc.gov.uk) to ensure every young person benefits from access to resources that reduce their risk of being impacted by crime.

Early intervention is key: stopping problems from escalating, educating and supporting children and young people to prevent them from being drawn into criminal activity.
